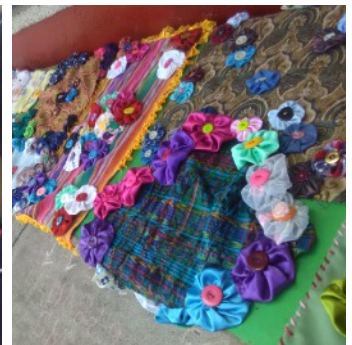
SPELLING BEE
